- Outer islands: As well as stories about many of the individual atolls, this extensive section includes a chart for each atoll, photos of most, and facts for all
- Brief introduction to the Marshallese language (with sound) and dictionary
- History, government, and education
- Industry (including the Marshall Islands Chamber of Commerce).
